POSTOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR DILATATION AND CURRETTAGE

- 1. Resume normal activity as soon as effects of anesthesia have worn off. This may be 24 hours
- 2. Cramps may occur for one to 2 days and should respond to Motrin, Ibuprofen or Tylenol
- 3. Light bleeding may occur for several days
- 4. Call if you soak a pad every hour for 2 hours
- 5. Call if you have a temperature of 100.4 or higher, cramps last for more than 48 hours, increasing pain, foul smelling odor, or prolonged heavy bleeding.
